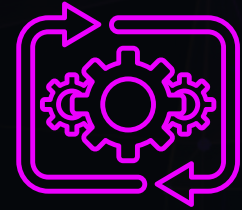

AUTOMATE REPETITIVE TASKS

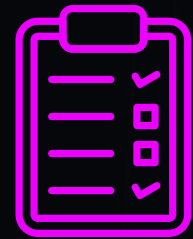
Do away with manual and repetitive tasks like scanning reconciliations and updating checklists.

KNOW STATUS AT ALL TIMES

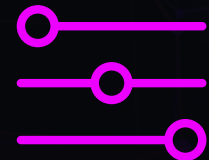
Real-time status information goes a long way in reducing bottle-necks and last minute delays.

PROACTIVELY ADDRESS RISK

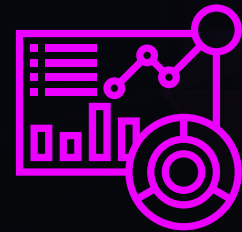
Reduce the likelihood of violating internal controls by replacing existing detective controls with preventive controls.
